Perfect Pancakes

2 cups unbleached all-purpose flour

2 cups buttermilk

(Pillsbury or Gold Medal)

1/4 cup sour cream

2 T granulated sugar

2 eggs

1 t baking powder1/2 t baking soda

3 T unsalted butter, melted & cooled slightly

1-2 t vegetable oil for greasing the pan

1/2 t salt

Whisk the flour, sugar, baking powder, baking soda & salt together in medium bowl. In second medium bowl, whisk together the buttermilk, sour cream, eggs & melted butter. Make a well in the center of the dry ingredients & pour in the wet ingredients; gently stir until just combined (batter should remain lumpy with a few streaks of flour). Do not overmix. Allow the batter to sit for 10 min before cooking.

Heat 1 t vegetable oil in a nonstick skillet over medium heat until shimmering. Using a paper towel, carefully wipe out oil, leaving a thin film of oil on the bottom of the pan. Using 1/4 cup measure, portion batter into pan in 4 places. Cook until edges are set, first side is golden brown, & bubbles on surface are just beginning to break, 2-3 min. Using a thin, wide spatula, flip pancakes & continue to cook until second side is golden brown, 1-2 min longer. Serve pancakes immediately. Repeat with remaining batter, using remaining oil as needed.
