"Do Not Call List" Customer Notice

This notice is being provided in accordance with the regulations of the Federal Communications Commission (FCC), 47 CFR 64.1200(g), regarding the National Do Not Call List.

The National Do Not Call List is a database maintained by the federal government. Under federal law, you may elect to use the National Do Not Call database to register your objection to receiving telephone solicitations. If you elect to do so, you can register with the database by making a toll free call to 888-382-1222. For TTY access, call 866-290-4236. You may register online at www.donotcall.gov.

If you use the National Do Not Call List to register an objection to receiving telephone solicitations, you may later revoke that objection if you choose.



Bacon Mushroom Honey Dijon Chicken

1/3 c Dijon Mustard 1/3 c honey 1/2 t lemon juice

6 boneless, skinless chicken breast halves

3 T olive oil 1/2 t salt 1/4 t pepper

3 c sliced fresh mushrooms

12 bacon strips, cooked & crumbled 3 green onions, sliced

1 1/2 c shredded Monterey Jack cheese

2 (4.3 oz) boxes long grain and wild rice

In a small bowl, combine the mustard, honey, and lemon juice. Set aside. In a large skillet over medium heat, cook chicken all the way through in 3 T of oil. Sprinkle with salt and pepper. Remove and set aside. In the same skillet, saute mushrooms with cooked bacon and green onions until tender. Remove and set aside. Add chicken breasts to skillet, top with cheese. Keep on skillet until the cheese is melted. When cheese is melted remove from skillet, place on a plate. Spoon the honey, mustard, and lemon juice mixture over the chicken. Top with the cooked mushrooms, bacon pieces and onions. Serve with long grain wild rice.

Are you Sick of Spam?

Spam is junk mail...unsolicited email. It's one of the most hated forms of advertising. There's no cure for spam once you start getting it. It seems to keep growing.

It's possible to avoid getting into the spammers' address books in the first place. The main thing is to never post your mail email address online. Whenever you fill out a form online, look for check boxes requesting permission for the company to send you email or to share your email address. Check "NO".

Since there is no cure, you can set up a different email account and use that address for online shopping, software registration, etc. While you can't always stop spammers from sharing your email address, you can take action to detour it.

Have you noticed lately that some status updates on Facebook appear

larger? It's not just you! While this feature hasn't been rolled out to everyone, some Facebook users are seeing larger typeface sizes in posts in their feed. The larger typeface is size 24, while the normal one is 14. The larger typeface appears to be used when text posts are 34 characters or fewer, and only when your post is just text (with no attachments like videos or articles). No one knows for sure why Facebook made this change, but experts speculate it's to draw attention to more personal posts.
