Caramel Apple Day - October 31st

Caramel Apple Muffins

3 c flour

1/2 tsp salt

2 tsp ground cinnamon

2 1/2 c chopped pecans, toasted

1/2 c butter (do not substitute)

1 tsp baking soda

3 c apples (cooking, tart)

2 c sugar 1 c oil

3 large eggs, lightly beaten

2 tsp vanilla

Peel and finely chop 3 cups of apples.

Stir sugar and next 3 ingredients in large bowl. Stir flour and next 3 ingredients. Add to sugar mix, stirring just till blended. Batter will be stiff. Fold in apples and 1 c pecans. Fill muffin tin cups 3/4 full & bake at 350 degrees for 25 minutes or until toothpick comes out clean. Remove from pan and cool. Poke with wooden spoon handle 1 inch deep. Spoon frosting over muffin. Sprinkle with remaining pecans.

Caramel Frosting:

2 (14 oz) cans sweetened condensed milk

1/2 c firmly packed brown sugar 1 t vanilla

Bring to a boil, stirring over medium low heat 3-5 minutes until pudding thick. (It always takes longer to get it to pudding thick.)


