Lifeline/Link-up

McDonough Telephone participates in two programs for low-income customers to help offset the cost of telephone and broadband service. Link-Up Assistance provides a one-time credit towards installation of residential phone or broadband service. Lifeline assistance provides a monthly credit on the subscriber's phone/broadband bill. Eligible customers must reside in a household with either a residential phone line or internet service and receive benefits from one of the following programs:

- Medicaid
- Supplemental Nutrition Assistance Program (SNAP)
- Supplemental Security Income (SSI)
- Federal Public Housing Assistance (FPHA)
- Veterans Pension or Survivors Benefits Program
- Household annual income at or below 135% of the Federal Poverty Guidelines

There are several options to apply for Lifeline. You may apply directly through the Lifeline programs National Verifier online portal (https://www.checklifeline.org/lifeline). You may also apply for the program by working with a Lifeline service provider either in-person at a store location or online via the service provider's website, if they support that option. 



Affordable Connectivity Program Helping Households Connect

The FCC's Affordable Connectivity Program

The Affordable Connectivity Program is a Federal Communications Commission program that helps connect families and households struggling to afford internet service. This new benefit provides a discount of up to \$30 per month toward broadband service for eligible households. Eligible households can also receive a one-time discount of up to \$100 to purchase a laptop, desktop computer, or tablet from **participating** providers. The ACP is non-transferable and limited to one monthly internet discount per household.

Eligible households can enroll through a participating broadband provider or directly with the Universal Service Administrative Company (USAC) using an online or mail in application.

Recipe Of The Month

Recipe: Easy Greek Pasta Salad

Ingredients:

I pound short cut pasta
I cucumber chopped
I cup grape tomatoes, halved
I red bell pepper, chopped
I/2 red onion, sliced thinly
4 oz Feta cheese, cubed
I/2 cup black olives, halved
Dressing:
I/4 cup olive oil

3 tbsp red wine vinegar 1/2 tsp dried oregano

1/2 tsp garlic powder

1/4 tsp kosher salt

1/8 tsp ground black pepper 2 tbsp fresh dill finely chopped

Directions:

In a large pot of boiling water, cook the pasta according to the instructions.

Drain and place in a large bowl.

Add the cucumber, tomatoes, bell pepper, red onion, feta and olives to the bowl.

To make the dressing, combine all the dressing ingredients in a small bowl and whisk.

Pour over the bowl of pasta salad ingredients and toss together carefully.

The Easy Greek Pasta Salad can be served cold or at room temperature.
