

Recipe: Pesto Chicken Pasta Casserole



16 ounces penne pasta 4 boneless skinless chicken breasts cooked and shredded, could also use rotisserie chicken ½ cup milk

4 cups shredded mozzarella cheese

3 cups baby spinach

1 (15 oz) can diced tomatoes, drained

1 (15 oz) jar alfredo sauce

½ cup prepared pesto

½ cup plain bread crumbs

½ cup grated Parmesan cheese 1 Tablespoon olive oil

Directions:

Preheat oven to 350 degrees F. Cook pasta according to package directions, drain and set aside.

In a large mixing bowl, combine pasta, chicken, milk, mozzarella cheese, baby spinach, diced tomatoes, Alfredo sauce and pesto. Mix until well combined.

Spread mixture into a 9×13-inch baking pan sprayed with nonstick cooking spray.

In a small mixing bowl, combine bread crumbs, Parmesan cheese and olive oil.

Sprinkle crumb mixture on top of casserole.

Bake for 35-40 minutes, or until crumb topping is golden brown and casserole is heated through.
