An Important Message About Illinois Relay

The Illinois Telecommunications Access Corporation (ITAC) provides telecommunications relay service in Illinois to people who are Deaf, Hard-of-hearing, Speech-Disabled, or Deaf-Blind and allows them to place and receive calls to standard telephone users via a keyboard or assistive device. Illinois Relay is a free service, available 24 hours a day, 7 days a week. Trained operators type the hearing caller's spoken words to the TTY caller and speak the typed words to the hearing person. Calls are billed at regular telephone company rates. ITAC also distributes TTYs at no charge to qualified Illinois Residents.

Recipe: Puppy Chow Chocolate Truffles

Ingredients:

Puppy Chow Mixture 4 cups rice Chex l cup peanut butter % cup powdered sugar

Coating 2 cups semi sweet chocolate chips ½ cup powdered sugar Directions:

Add peanut butter & powdered sugar to a bowl. Microwave in 10 second intervals, stirring in between each one, until melted & smooth. Place cereal in a large bowl. Crush it into small pieces, leaving some bigger pieces as well. Pour the peanut butter mixture into the cereal. Combine. Put the mixture in the fridge for 30 min.

Add the chocolate chips to a double boiler. Melt. Remove the cereal mixture from the fridge. Roll the mixture into about 1 ½ tosp sized balls. You should be able to make about 18 truffles. Coat the balls in the melted chocolate. Then place in the refrigerator for the chocolate coating to harden.

Add the powdered sugar (½ cup) to a bowl. Once the chocolate has hardened, roll the truffles in the powdered sugar. Enjoy!
